Lankenau Medical Center offers multifaceted education and outreach to children and adults in the community. In FY25, Lankenau provided 163 virtual and in-person programs for more than 8,200 students in K-12 and a similar number of adult programs. Its Deaver Wellness Farm provided school programs and grew 2,700 pounds of fresh produce. Produce and other food staples were delivered to thousands of patients in need.

MEDICAL EDUCATION

Lankenau has a long tradition of excellence in medical education and first trained house officers in 1860. Our first "modern" residency program was in Internal Medicine, which started in 1946. Today, 210 residents and fellows participate in 15 residency and fellowship programs.

Lankenau Institute for Medical Research (LIMR) is a nonprofit biomedical research institute whose mission is to improve human health and well-being through innovative approaches to medical challenges. LIMR's principal investigators conduct basic, preclinical and translational research, using their findings to explore ways to improve disease detection, diagnosis, treatment and prevention.
